What is a Neighbourhood plan?

There are just over 200 houses in Ewelme Village (excluding those on the RAF base). The draft South Oxfordshire District Council Policy calls for small villages like ours to deliver a 5-10% increase of the number of houses from now until 2032. This equates to 10-20 households and includes any new builds that have had approval granted since 2011.

In order to have any say and influence over the type of housing and where they should be, we need a Neighbourhood Plan.

What are we doing in Ewelme?

We are working on a Neighbourhood plan. The input of everyone in the village is important and your support is vital to the adoption of the plan. There are many stages before completion. Shortly, you will be asked to complete a Questionnaire.
